

Facts are dispensed on the spreads, and there is no hard and fast organization. While there is an extensive index, this work is aimed at browsers, not report writers. The cartoon artwork is colorful, but the illustrations falter when it comes to people. Limbs are sometimes out of proportion, and people occasionally seem awkward. Animals are better rendered. The endpapers are a delight: the front sheets are covered with monarch butterflies, while the back pages depict penguins, swimming off at the bottom right corner of the spread. There's a "Can You"

This book is pretty cool. I do wish it had more detailed maps though. It has the big picture world map, then a map for each continents but no details such as islands and or capitals or other cities. I also wish it was perhaps bigger - as in that it covered more cool things in more countries. It kind of only touches on a handful of interesting things from each continent and that leaves out a LOT. What they do cover is interesting and is done well. This is from someone who has actually been to a number of places around the world. But as for my young children they will probably enjoy it.

Really fun, my 2nd grader took to it right away. Just as a high-maintenance designer I wish the printing was a little better so the colors really sang, but the illustrations are fun and the ideas are great.

The hardback cover will protect the pages, the illustrations are colorful and will help to teach children about different countries and their cultures. Highly recommend this book.
