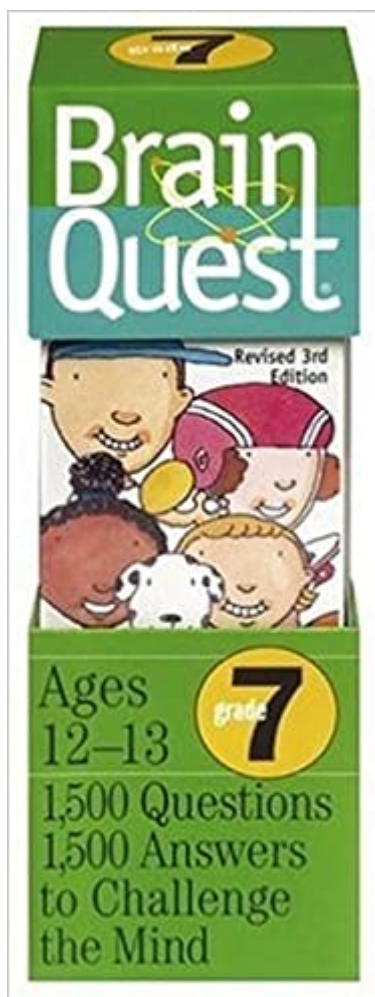

We've used these Brain Quests for years, mostly at the dinner table for fun. I'm sad that they seem to stop at 7th Grade, as they are just fun and informative for everyone.

Love using these as a time filler in my classroom. Students occasionally finish early in class, and this gives me something educational and fun to use with them. Some of the questions are very easy to figure out, while they struggle with others. There is a good amount of challenge, so it makes it very fun for my kids.

Nothing to sing about. The questions were sort of weird...nobody knew most of the answers, including adults.

I am going through the Questions and Answers and will be using them at an Assisted Living location where I hold a weekly Trivial Pursuit meeting. When I told them there would be 7th (and 6th) Grade questions/answers, they were a little apprehensive -- for good reason, I might add. A number of the Q&As had me stumped! That's good!!

Always fun and challenging for 7th graders and beyond. I admit some questions were a challenge. Makes trivia fun and easy to use. I use in a classroom setting to challenge students during slow, or in-between times. Rewards of a candy bar or granola bar with high scores for the week make students pay attention. It has also took on a challenge on some topics that are presented and used as side homework projects. Fun !

These obviously slipped through the QA process. I was very disappointed that the deck of cards was put together wrong - cards not in order, some frontwards, some backward, some upside down. They are not easy to take apart, and don't want to risk loose cards everywhere.

Nephew is a Brain Quest fan, and had this on his Xmas wish list. He seemed very pleased to get it. I can't personally attest to this particular edition, but I'm sure he'll enjoy it. His mom tells me she

believes this product lines has helped him in school.

I have this neighbor kid who is passing classes but uneducated as a rock. I gave her these to play with and she taunts her mom (nice to have the answers, isn't it Mr. Trebeck?) so her mom is unhappy but by osmosis it may settle a little on SOMEBODY. Recommend you have the kids play as a game, anything that takes on fertile mental soil is a win.
