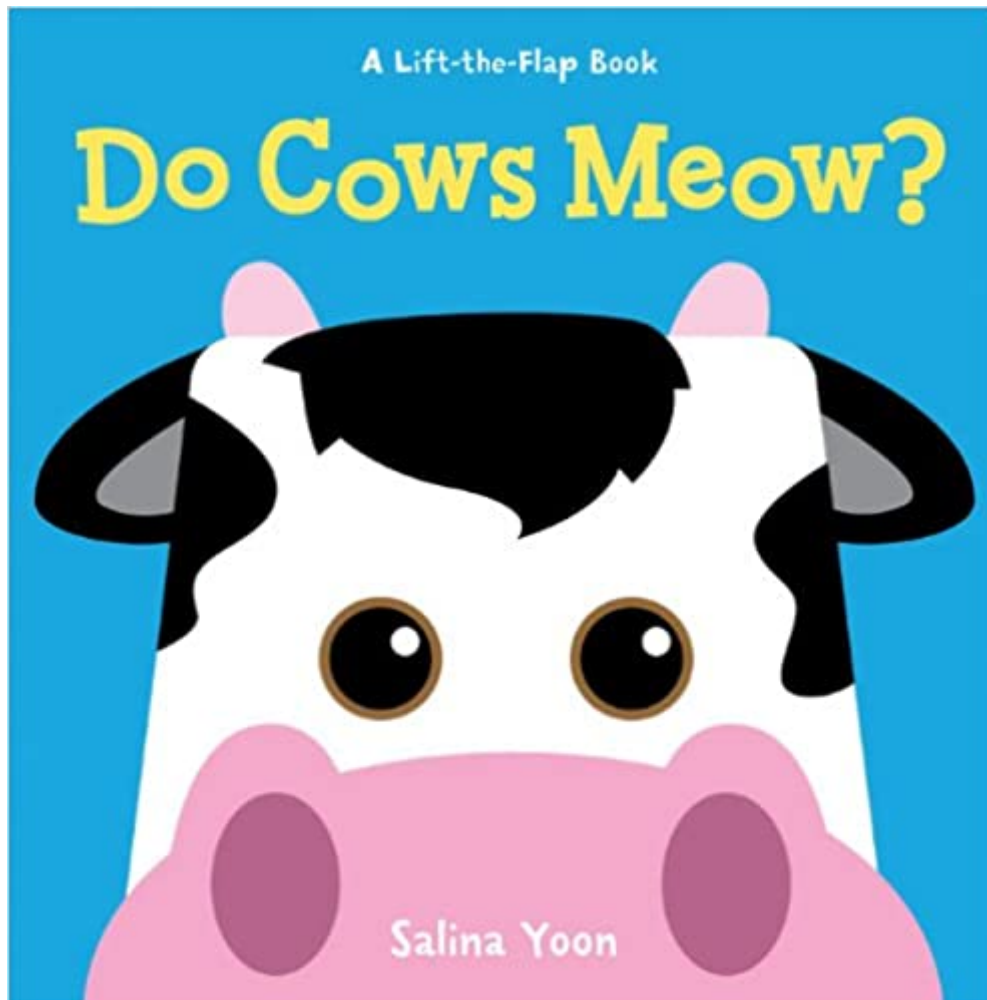

This book is great! My nine month old loves it. The book is bigger than I was expecting and the pages are more sturdy than just regular paper so he can pull on the and it won't rip.

Baby loves this book. It's large and colorful. Fun to read with him. We added a little clear packing tape to all the flaps (both sides) just for extra support since baby is 9 months and tries to rip everything. Although book is made much better and stronger than most lift-the-flap book. Really happy with purchase and would highly recommend!

This book is ok. It looks very nice... colorful and shiny. I got it to use with toddlers for my work. I prefer another similar lift-the-flap book, Peek-A-Moo. In Do Cows Meow?, the flaps, which are on a thin slippery /slick paper and difficult for toddlers (and sometimes, adults!) to lift, reveal the mouths of the animals. The kids I work with have shown minimal interest in this book and I have not gotten much use out of it in the months I have had it.

My 14 month old absolutely loves this book. It's much larger than I was anticipating, and each page has a flip up/interactive flap. I purchased mostly because my baby loves Cows and making the Moo sound right now, but this book also has an adorable duck, sheep, pig, mouse, and frog I believe as main characters. Super adorable and very fun. This momma even got tired of reading it on repeat last night, so you know it's a hit when you're toddler wants it read 55 times in a row.

My own fault for not reading up on this more, but I didn't realize this book has thin, paper-like flaps (to lift). I got it for my son for his first birthday and he almost destroyed every flap the first read through, haha. I'm sure as he gets older he will enjoy it but it will have to be put on the high shelf for a while yet. :)

How can you NOT like this book for toddlers and preschool kiddos?! I'm an Auditory-Verbal Therapist, and I read it frequently in my therapy sessions.

My 5 month old LOVES this book and she laughs out loud and smiles. I will be buying the other

book by the same author. The baby was interested in the book since she was 2-3 months old, when she wasn't interested in other books. But now she smiles and laughs when I read it to her. I think it's because it's a big book and she isn't too distracted by her surroundings

My 15 month old son loves this book. The pictures are bright and colorful. The pages are laminated and tough for a grabby little one. My reason for the low 3 star rating? The flaps cling to the pages and are very hard to lift. I need to start them for my son so he can grasp them (he has other flap books he can do easily). Even my fingernail-less husband has difficulties with the flaps. I wouldn't discourage you from buying this book - like I said my son loves it. Just don't expect that the kids will be able to do this without parental help.
