

A good horror setting where you must balance between keeping your grades good and finding out what supernatural things occur in the small town of Pinebox. This book is really top quality, and has some really awesome features, like a really creative adventure generator with 3 detailed examples and a demon generator which is a really cool tool to have. It also has everything else that's needed, like important and generic NPCs, a bestiary, a map of the university campus and a map of the town itself, rules for both exams and ritual magic, etc.

That'll set you back another ten bucks. Also, there's a Plot Point Campaign book called "Degrees of Horror" that takes players all the way from Freshman Orientation to Graduation Day, and I heartily recommend grabbing that book, too, even if just for the "Savage Tales" included in its back half. That can take a lot of work out of running the game, making it as much fun to run as "Dean" (what the ETU setting calls the GM) as well as the "Study Group" (ETU's term for the player characters as a whole). I've been running this setting and its Plot Point Campaign book for the past year or so, and it's been great. The end of each adventure has my players clamoring for the next one. If you enjoy shows like Buffy the Vampire Slayer, Supernatural, The X-Files, and American Horror Story, this setting should be a lot of fun for you.

I have a hard time really describing how much I love this setting. East Texas University is everything that Buffy: The Vampire Slayer did right wrapped up with classic American horror, and the spectrum of genre that includes. If Scooby Doo and crew had been designed for adults and created by the hybrid freak child of Wes Kraven and Stephen King, yeah then you are pretty close.
