

This is a good, sturdy reference for field use. Do to its size, it is limited to 45 snakes, 24 frogs & toads, 18 turtles, 25 lizards, and 3 crocodilians. The color pictures do a adequate job, but the description of each could use a little bit more, such as common locations.

Unlike a bulky book, these North American Nature Guides are compact, durable and portable. Our grandson, age 5, has a collection of them, studies them, and refers to them frequently to identify wildlife.
