

After the war Udet used his flying skills to give displays to crowds of gawping onlookers, a circus act that left him frustrated and resentful. In 1941, disillusioned and depressed, he shot himself. On the wall before he died he scrawled a message for $G\tilde{A}f\hat{A}$ fring: $\tilde{A}\phi\hat{a}$ ¬ \tilde{E} celron man, you have betrayed me $\tilde{A}\phi\hat{a}$ ¬ \hat{a},ϕ .

Born in 1896, Ernst Udet joined the infant German Air Service in 1915. He went onto win the Iron Cross First Class and Pour le Merite. Between the wars Udet became a stunt pilot. In 1939 he was put in charge of air force development and production, but on 17 November 1941, he killed himself.

A very interesting read...

I am somewhat of expert on Von Richthofen but Udet was a mystery to me and after reading this shockingly well-written and fascinating book, Udet is now more of an enigma to me and perhaps will lead me to him and away from the Baron.

His history is covered from WW1 to the beginning of WW2. I did not know that this pilot was such a great aces. This book isn't just about WWI but covers Udet's life after the war. There isn't any talk in the book about Goering and the Nazis which would have been interesting. He does mention Goering briefly as Goering was Udet's commander during WWI.
