

The book comforted me as I struggled through the grief process. The pain was still intense but I could cope. I am hoping the updated version will have new stories and I highly recommend it in ANY version to the grieving pet owner. There are stories about dogs, cats, and rats. Maybe other pets too, I don't remember. After reading about the wonderful rats Kim loved, my husband and I found an abandoned domestic rat in a park and rescued him. Templeton just passed away - I am so sad. I need this book again, but I gave away all my copies to suffering friends when their pets passed...now the first version seems to be out of print. After these stories no one can look at an animal in the same way again. Even those of us who thought we knew our pets. They have their existence beyond this world just as we do. Very moving.

I would STRONGLY recommend this book to anybody who suffers (or has suffered) grief over having lost a pet. Of all the books that I have read on the subject, this is by far the best. It is full of valuable information. Chapters deal with such subjects as how to deal with grief, how our deceased pets try to contact us, etc., etc.We know that animals do go to Heaven, if we have studied the near-death experiences of humans (as I have done for many years), since many of those experiencers have reported being met by their pets as well as seeing other animals while having their near-death experience. This book helps us clarify that knowledge while giving us a tremendous amount of additional information regarding the subject. Again, I would urge anybody suffering grief over the loss of a pet, anybody having a friend suffering such grief, and/or anybody who loves animals to read this book.

This book doesn't need another gushing review, but I'm going to write one anyway. I bought this book a couple weeks after losing Ella, my beloved Maine Coon of 8 1/2 years, to a high grade sarcoma in her gums. Kim's book was a tremendous help in giving me peace about some feelings of guilt I had about the day of Ella's death. I was in tears reading about the relationship between Kim & her beloved pet rat June, because it was so similar to the relationship I had with Ella. It's a great comfort to me to know that our animal companions are still with us in spirit after death, and that we will be reunited with them in the afterlife. Being a vegetarian, I also applaud Kim's efforts to make people aware that cows, pigs & chickens have feelings & fear being killed to be eaten because they, too, want to live. Everyone who has loved & lost a pet, whether they currently have a pet or not, needs to read this book! I also recommend it if you love animals & are just curious about this subject. I'm going to buy a copy of this book for my sister for Christmas, because she asked the priest of the church she belongs to about this very subject after having to have one of her beloved cats put to sleep.
