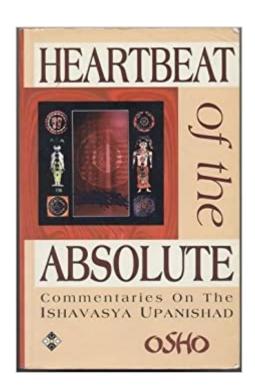


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# Heartbeat Of The Absolute: Discourses On The Ishavasya Upanishad
