

This FODOR book has tons of GREAT INFOrmation about Disney world. The preface in particular has some fantastic advice about how to spend your day as a family. How to make sure everyone gets to do something fun, how to pace yourself, when's the best time to rest, and how the meal plan is really useful. Having gone to Disney World not too long ago, I can verify that this advice is sound. only wish the rest of the book was as straightforward and easily used. The first chapter, for example, immediately made me feel overwhelmed. There was detailed information about dining packages and hotel packages and parking packages, and while that's all very important, I really think it would have been better to have briefly introduced the topics of what you needed to consider without delving into so much detail. I decided, for example, on our trip that I wanted to wake up and drink coffee while watching zebras graze. That was on my wishlist and since that required we stay onsite, parking was never an issue. So I could have skipped all that info in this book. And I'm sure you'll have areas you can skip. Which means... you should skim the chapters at first. For me, if I were planning another trip or a first trip I would read all about what there is to do, and then I would figure out how much time and money we had to spend and use. There's so much there at Disney World that time and money are going to be big limiters. So start there. Then delve into the excellent information this book has.SUMMARYThe FODOR DISNEY 2015 book is an excellent resource. The best book on Disney that I've read. BUT you are going to have to force your own logical structure on how you use it. At least for me because they give you more information than you actually need. The book gives information about every park and every hotel. How to get fast passes and meal plans that will work for your family. It doesn't cover extraneous other parks like Busch Gardens and I'd have been pretty annoyed if it had. Disney is enough to cope with. My advice is to NOT approach

the design of your vacation the way it's presented in the book. Do a lot of skimming and then come back and read the parts you really need to understand. Really need the Princess Tea Party/character meals? Read that section. Going as adults? Read the parts about the fine dining. Staying onsite? Skip the parts about parking. This book has everything. I just found the structure to be useless to me.

If you've never been to WDW before, then this book might be a good starting off point. As a 35+ times guest, I found much of the information to be a bit thin and somewhat snarky. With the amount of information needed, the book did not need to include off property attractions - first timers need to focus not try to do all of Orlando. There is little depth here - esp the hotels and restaurants. Each hotel needs its own chapter to allow for a really educated decision. Saying Wilderness Lodge looks like Lincoln logs or that Port Orleans Riverside is Huck Finn dating Scarlett is not helpful and rather insulting to those that love the property. There are far better resources out there that will give you the detail you need before booking - Disney's website for one! Restaurants are treated with the same glib sketchiness. Those looking for insider tips will miss out completely here - the tip for best spot for parade watching?? Grab a curb 30 min early. Not only is this not a tip, you won't find a curb open 30 min prior to parade time.
