

By no means do you have to be involved in real estate to enjoy the book. Any reader will appreciate the author's gumption and inside look at deals, human nature, and what it takes to be a winner when working for yourself and building a

business. Cherie can tell a story - and how! I so look forward to checking out other books she's written. That's a reaction a reader is more likely to have when reading fiction by a talented author but in this case, I'm convinced that anything else Miller writes will be equally engaging. She's got top notch sales skills and her writing talents are equally impressive. I'd give this book ten stars if I could!

Mildly entertaining, and certainly a few nuggets about the industry, but I would say this book is largely the author's memoir, with lots of personal stories, told in sort of a folksy way, about her unique experience as a real estate agent. Again, you'll learn a few decent tips, but what she shares seems to be more about her personal style as an agent (super ambitious / go-getter) - rather than an overview of the industry.
