This book is one of the better personal finance books I've read. The author begins by sharing that he grew up in poverty, which is very meaningful to me. It's hard to take financial experts who have never had to struggle financially seriously. They don't know what the average person goes through, but this author does. (I also like that he makes himself very accessible to readers--he actually shares his personal email address at the end of the book. I haven't reached out to him yet, but will be sure to if I have any questions later). The substance of the book is also very helpful. He covers all aspects of personal finance, from budgeting to saving to investing to finding ways of earning more money. He is honest and thoughtful, never condescending. He uses straightforward language and gives practical advice. Some of his tips seem commonsense when you read them, but his explanation really adds some meat to their bones and gives you more motivation to actually follow the advice. This is a book that will stay in my virtual library for a long time. I really appreciate the advice found inside and I am happy to recommend it to anyone who wants to improve their personal finance knowledge and/or behaviors.
