

Granted, this is a few years old, but it was likely out of date even then. The information in this paperback is readily accessible online virtually anywhere-you aren't getting anything exceptionally helpful or detailed. The information is so general that one would suspect it of fitting in more with a

high school English class than for a freelancer. Additionally, you aren't given the contact information as Writer's Market supplies. A few things: plagiarism is covered in 2 or 3 pages. Not only is it very basic knowledge, but it doesn't even explain the different styles of citation. "Editor" tips are also basic...a little bit of time on Google and you'd likely yield more precise information from better sources. Save your money....

The book is well-meaning but extremely outdated, wrong in several instances and doesn't provide a clear path on how to become a top writer. Many of the tips are no longer applicable and I only found two of the pages helpful. If you have any writing background, save your money and get something more current and more in-depth.
