(Excerpted from the Introduction) So, you're putting on a Messianic Passover seder. You get the applause if everything goes smoothly. And if it doesn't… well… but don't even think about that. Of course it will go smoothly. We're helping you, right? Right! A friend of ours has a catchy way to describe the principles of management. She says, "We recruit, educate, motivate, and delegate!" It has a certain ring, doesn't it? Keep this in mind as you prepare your Messianic Passover seder. Whether you are having a table-full, a room-full, or a social hall-full of people for this beautiful, meaningful experience, it is essential to get your helpers recruited, educated, motivated, and delegated. 1. Recruiting You probably already know the people you can approach and count on for help. For a small family seder this may not be more than one helper. But for an entire congregation, "the more the merrier." Call together your group of volunteers for a meeting after services or at someone's home over dessert. (That will keep you from getting hungry as you discuss the delicious Passover menu.) 2. Educating Why not begin by sitting down with The Messianic Passover Haggadah and treating yourself and your helpers to a little preview of the event to come? It might be easier to attack the task of preparing for Passover when the meaning of that preparation is understood. Working toward a goal can be much more pleasant when everyone can envision and understand that goal. 3. Motivating Some of the instructions in our guide need to be strictly followed. For example, the Bible is very clear to say that leavened products are off-limits at Passover. Also,

we have suggested two alternative menus. Think of it as choosing something from Column A and something from Column B. Choosing the menu ought to be helpful in motivating your recruits. And sharing with them the joy people will receive from participating in the seder will be motivational as well. 4. Delegating This is most important of all. Don't assume the entire burden of this project. Some of your volunteers will be food preparers, some setter-uppers, some servers, and some cleaner-uppers. Decide in advance what part you wish to play in this procedure and be sure to delegate the rest. Remember, you are the conductor, not the entire orchestra….

Lent and Easter are very important to our family and celebrating Passover is one of our favorite traditions! My mother-in-law is a Messianic Jew and so I became very interested in Jewish customs that foreshadowed the Messiah. I also wanted my children to know about that part of their heritage. I did a lot of research to learn how to prepare and celebrate the Passover with different resources. I was thrilled when I found this little book at our library and ordered my own. It tells you exactly what to read during the meal, keeps it clear and not too long. My kids are 6, 4, and 2, and they have learned so much from celebrating the Passover meal which engages all their senses for the best type of learning and retention! God knew implementing traditions that tell stories was the way to help children remember His faithfulness and love for His people!

For the first time, the Christian believer can take the same spiritual journey as it was meant to be taken with Christ as the center, as our Jewish brethren have been doing for centuries. This will bring the whole purpose of the Old Testament and the fulfillment of Messiah's purpose into a whole new light for many. Many Christians will understand we were never meant to be separated from the Passover Seder, as it was the Last Supper of Christ.

This guide came with the Passover Seder Plate that I purchased. I was very grateful for the guide, it is well done and covers the entire aspect of the Passover Seder Dinner. The only guide I had seen before was the one put out by Maxwell House that was very good. This one is about as nice as that one and gives you the whole dinner and the scripture and prayers and guides for even the children's time. It also gives you the preparation of the home, the meal and yourself to properly prepare yourself for the dinner both physically as well as spiritually. I enjoyed the guide, and was happy to receive as part of getting the passover seder plate that I purchased.

This pamphlet was used as a resource for our recent Maundy Thursday service. It provided a lot of

good information. I especially liked the humorous comments and the recipes and the menu recommendations. The service was a great success.

This is everything you need to prepare for the Seder. My Hebrew professor encouraged use to purchase a copy this is my fifth. It is great for Believers wanting to study our Jewish Roots of our Faith. I highly recommend it

The booklet is a 5 page xerox copy folded in half and stapled together. Half the book is unreadable. Some of the pages look like they are copies of copies and bad copies at that. There are 4 pages of basic recipes that can be found anywhere and 4 pages of unreadable music due to poor copying with no translation from Hebrew to English. Since you can't read the music I guess it doesn't matter! The booklet offered little or no real information on the culture and Jewish traditions. Save your money!Mr. Rubin, consider the price of your booklet as a donation to your organization.
