

Brahms And Bruckner As Artistic Antipodes: Studies In Musical Semantics





Synopsis

In the last third of the 19th century Brahms and Bruckner were regarded as antipodes. Is this perception really true to the historical reality or had their contemporaries overestimated the à «dimension of their distanceà », as argued later? Both wrote autonomously conceived music, both held on to traditional forms, and both rejected program music. To find an answer to this question, part I tries to elucidate Brahmsââ ¬â,¢ relation to Bruckner in its biographic, historical, artistic and art-theoretical aspects. At the center of the second part, whose subject is Brahms¢â $\neg \hat{a}_{,,}$ ¢ early work, is the question whether Brahms was indeed an autonomously working composer.
