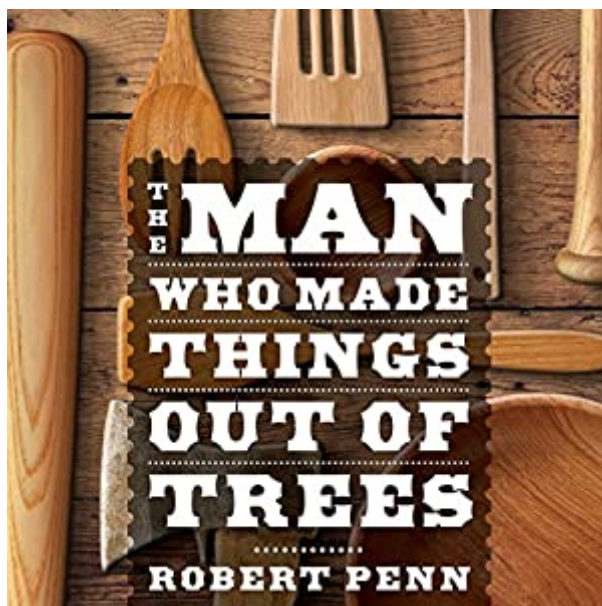

His journey takes him to a number of craftsmen in a wide variety of trades. Some of them the last of their kind, more artist than artisan. From wheelwrights, to tool makers, baseball bats, bowls, arrows shafts and anything else you could use ash for. The narrative of their stories are some of the best parts of the book. Interesting project with items made to last a lifetime. It's a good book and a quick read.
