

Starred Review. PreSchool-Grade 1Ā¢â ¬â •Humble green peas provide inspiration in this hilarious, occupation-based romp through the alphabet. Four-inch-high letters on each page serve as an ingenious architectural platform around, above, and inside of which dozens of "pea-ple" swarm in joyful pursuit of myriad types of work. Bouncy, rhyming text introduces the alphabet peas as "acrobats, artists, and astronauts in space, builders, bathers, and bikers in a race," with unpaid "voters and volunteers" receiving their due, too. Baker's inventive details belie the "as alike as two peas in a pod" adage; each and every amusing personalized pea is as unique as a

snowflake \tilde{A} ¢ \hat{a} ¬ \hat{a} •and that's the point. The digitally rendered illustrations glow in vibrant, textured colors that boldly leap off the page against a background of ample white space. This cheerful alphabet book introduces each letter as a large, colorful shape surrounded by tiny pea creatures, green circles with arms, legs, eyes, mouths, and occasionally accessories such as hats, diving masks or flippers. The pea folk demonstrate occupations and actions beginning with each letter and identified in the rhyming, rhythmic text. The letters L, M, N, and O, which so often run meaninglessly together in the alphabet song, appear on the same double-page spread. Most of the other letters appear on their own pages or spreads, while the four pages devoted to the little characters \tilde{A} ¢ \hat{a} $-\hat{a}$,¢ own letter, P, illustrate the lines \tilde{A} ¢ \hat{a} $-\hat{a}$. This is one of my all-time favorite kids books. (For the record, I'm in my late 20s, female, and have plenty of friends having kids.) It's cute and catchy, educational, and fun. When my nephews got old enough they had fun finding the ladybugs on every page. (And some of those little buggers are hidden pretty well!) I usually keep a couple copies of this book on hand to include with baby shower gifts and it's always a hit!

Really cute little book. The only problem is that the font size of the text is small enough that I really need my reading glasses to read this to my granddaughter, and I don't always plan ahead and have them nearby. That is the one change I would make. (The letters of the alphabet are quite large; no problem reading those!) Otherwise, it is super cute.

created some very different little board books. Thank you.

I love this book. The board version is very nice because, not only can my 5 year old use it, my 1 year old can use it without tearing it apart (she loves to rip paper and bite--hard). I want her to be able to explore books and not worry about them being ruined beyond repair. I don't want to have to tell her no with books. I don't have to worry with this board book, she can handle it to her hearts content.

My almost 3 year old loves ID'ing the letters, even though he calls A "pizza" before he calls it A... :) Keith Baker is so creative.

My son is 19 months. We have been reading The Green Pea series for a few months. This book and the color one is his favorite. This book goes through the alphabet and different careers you can become later. It is also very colorful. I would definitely recommend!

A cute way to start introducing your kids to the alphabet. My daughter still loves this book even though she has mastered her ABCs. We have fun looking for peas with different features (e.g. count how many peas are wearing glasses, which pea is driving the purple car, etc.) as well as finding the ladybug on each page.

A great book for teaching little kids about careers. We make a pea chain after we read the book, where the kids have to draw a career on their pea based on the letter they get. Then we string them up around the classroom.
