What a beautiful book from the cover to the text to the images, it just shows that a hardback book can still rule over the electronic book images. The 36 views cover so many facets of building the Eiffel and its effect on Parisian landscape, many of the etchings also show the loneliness of humans being surrounded by beauty. Many etchings might remind you of Japanese prints or art deco. What a lovely gift this would make for any francophile. The book has the original french text along with an english translation,too.

This book is a stunning recreation of Henri Riviere's original Thirty-Six Views of the Eiffel Tower. The paper and cover are of similar quality, the prints look beautiful, and even the original French text is included. These prints were part of a larger exhibit at the SF Legion of Honor called Â Japanesque: The Japanese Print in the Era of Impressionism. The exhibit was a rousing success, and the prints in this book -- all 36 of them framed in beautiful wooden frames -- were the highlight. I suggest buying two copies. One, you can keep on your bookshelf and pull out when you want to read the excellent translation of the French text. The other, you can take your favorite frame shop and hang on your wall, in 36 beautiful wooden frames. It'll be like starting your own museum.
