

Enjoy a Canadian view of the war of 1812. Typical of Canadian authors, it skews the facts to favor the Canadian role. (though the U.S. fought the British and not Canadians.) The book remains very worthy to give balance to the typical Americanized rendering of the war. The photos are very good.
