

Bottom line: it's a very good book, easy to read, and covers the topic very thoroughly. A must-have for anyone considering the treatment options available for prostate cancer.

Although I had some medical background and found this book to be helpful in anticipating and answering our questions about prostate cancer and our options; my husband found much of the book to be "mumbo-jumbo". There was a lot of medical terminology without enough simple definitions or explanations in plain simple English. The author addressed the topic thoroughly, but without enough simple explanation for the common person with no prior medical background. If you have had no prior medical background I think the book would be most helpful, if you highlighted or marked the areas you needed clarification on and then took it with you on your appointment with the doctor to discuss your diagnosis and options.

This is the first book I read as I explored prostate cancer, and it was a great introduction to the subject, giving me language and data that helped me focus my continued research in other books, on the web, and in discussion. It really contains a lot of helpful information in very clear, helpful language. The only reason I gave it 4 starts instead of 5 has more to do with the Kindle version than the book itself. The charts are very hard to read in the Kindle version; they are poorly copied. (Not to

mention that I was having trouble getting it synced across devices, and the idiot rep who I talked to on the phone told me to remove it from my device and download it again. He assumed I had an actual Kindle which keeps a backup, which I didn't. I read Kindle books on my Android phone and PC, and these version don't back up data. So I lost all bookmarks, notes, etc. Again, this is no reflection on the book or the author, just the poorly trained reps at Kindle.)

We were recommended this book by an oncologist. We each read it through several times and found it a great introduction to the disease. It's written in language that a layperson can understand, is well-organized, has section highlights, a very helpful glossary, good index, as well as charts and diagrams. It was just what we needed to begin to study this disease. As we do additional research, we have a good head start on knowing the basics. It can be a daunting read as it honestly states the advantages and disadvantages of each treatment option, but it's been extremely helpful.

I was diagnosed last April as having prostate cancer. The urologist recommended this book and also informed me that I needed to be sure to purchase the latest edition. It was very thorough in explaining the various stages of cancer and the options for treatment. What is really great about this selection is that there are charts which explain the various stages of this cancer and the pros and cons of the various treatments. Because of my age (56), and because of a family history of cancer, I opted to have a robotic prostectamy. So far, all of my tests have come back negative and the side effects are minimal. Because of the information given in this book, I was able to make an informed decision that I felt was best for my situation. I strongly recommend this book for anyone diagnosed with prostate cancer.
