

I can't fairly say if this issue to the book or the children's efforts or teacher. I think something must be going right because the band in middle school has tripled since their new teacher with his enthusiasm and the instructional book joined our district. I would like to see more vocabulary taught alongside the lessons as well as various interesting bits of information about instruments, composers as well as popular music terms. I think it's also very important that they focus on reading the time signature early on. The book appears to be a great book, those are my suggestions for newer editions in the future. Because my son's band has grown 3 grimes as large within a year they're adjusting!
