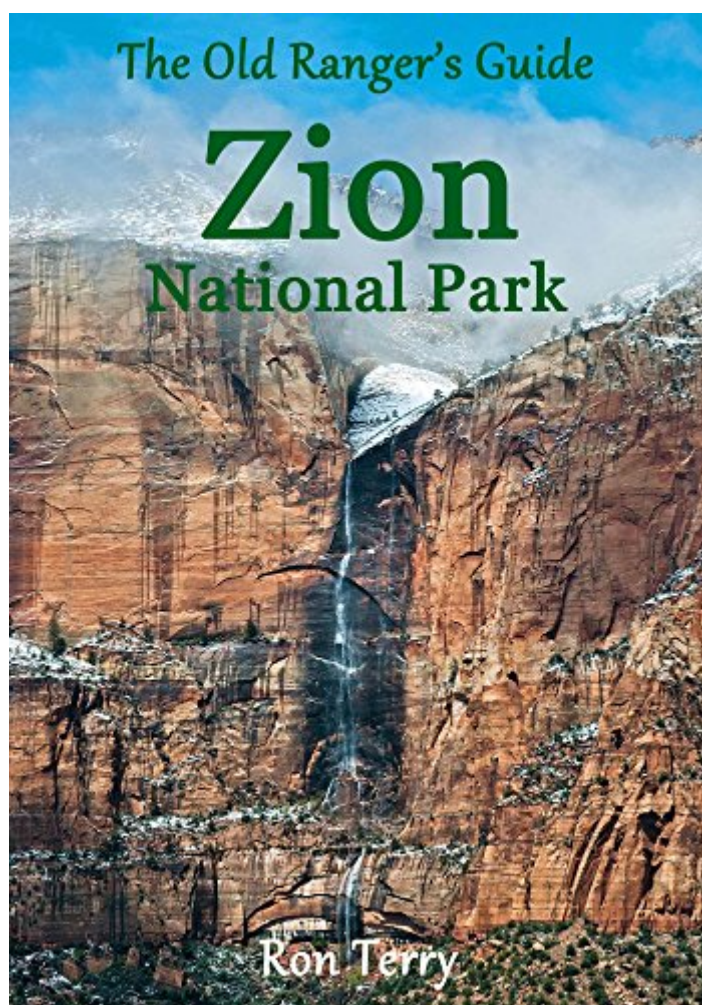

This is an extraordinary book -- it's written by a career park ranger who was the chief interpreter at Zion National Park for over ten years! It's quality is shockingly good, it is exceptionally readable and with just the right balance between detail and perspective. The attention to detail even carries over into the photography, which is fit for a gallery. This book is suitable both for the first time visitor and the seasoned traveler -- and it is good for both those who are visiting the Park by car and for those headed for the back country. It has plenty of links and maps that can be downloaded. It appears to be front loaded with the most frequently asked questions that the author must have encountered in his ten years behind the information desk and on the trail with visitors, but it provides an exceptionally thorough description and overview of all of the trails. The book also describes lesser known places -- probably the best places that rangers keep to themselves! Furthermore, the book provides suggestions on what to do with a half day visit, one day visit, or multiple day visit, and suggestions for different seasons as well. So many travel books these days feel as if they were mass produced -- this one feels like it was honed by a craftsman; perhaps even a work of love.
