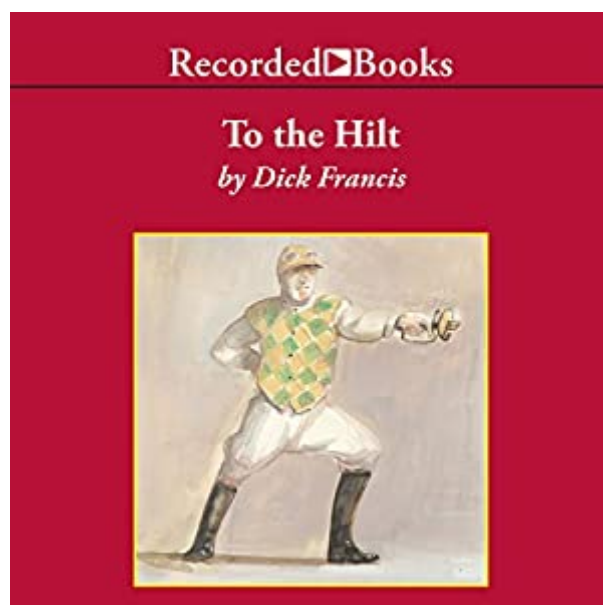

A fine mystery featuring an artist. The portions of the novel dealing with painting are so realistic that I paused my reading to research whether or not Francis ever painted. What I found was that his wife Mary conducted extensive research for Francis' novels, contributing greatly to their realism. This may not be one of Francis' strongest efforts so far as the mystery is concerned. However the main character, Alexander, is well developed and one of the more likeable of Francis' main characters whom I have encountered.

TO THE HILT is another smooth ride with Dick Francis. His first-person narration catches the reader's attention from the first sentence. His knowledge of racing: the sport, the business, the

tradition, are spot on. His heroes suffer, but they are victorious. Gallantry in action might well describe all of Francis's protagonists. If you read this mystery, you will be a winner just like Golden Malt.

I've read everything by my favorite detective fiction writers: Ed McBain, Robert Parker and others. Read all of Carl Hiaasen. I bought this when on sale to give it a try. Loved it. Fun to read. Fast paced. I look forward to starting at the beginning and reading all of his books.

I've just reread this, first read this many years ago and it holds up to a second reading. I would guess this is an early book. Alexander, the main character and narrator, is very complex and understated, but like most heroes exceptional.
