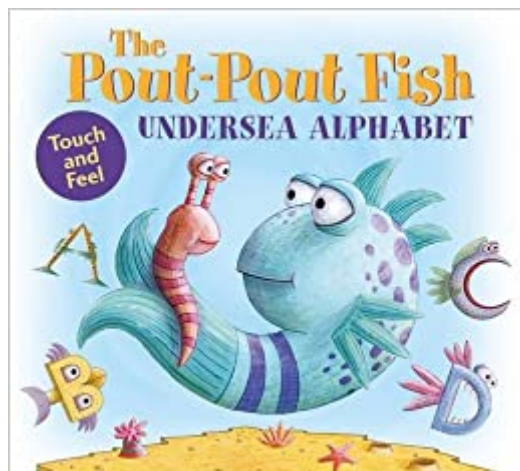

Let me start by saying that I ADORE Pout-Pout Fish. We just discovered the series this year, and I love the story, the illustrations, the rhymes... it rocketed to my "favorite board books" list almost immediately. I would try to convince my 3-year to choose it for his bedtime story every single night. So, when I saw that this was coming out (and was even the #1 new release in children's fish books!!), I pre-ordered like a boss. However, this book is just not good. The touch and feel aspect is probably one of the worst I've seen: only one texture per two-page spread, and the textures are

extremely redundant and boring. Almost all of them are a raised page sections (sometimes the raised sections are shiny), a few with glitter, one sticky, and that's about it. The content aspect is also lacking - there's no story, no rhymes or words at all, except something like "S is for Sea Horse" (which, by the way, is one word, not two). So, two or three of those per two-page spread. This book tries to do multiple things, and it just doesn't do any of them well. If you want touch-and-feel, go with My First Touch and Feel picture cards or the That's Not My... series. If you want alphabet, look for Chicka Chicka Boom Boom, LMNO Peas, or Dr. Seuss.

My whole family LOVE the original Pout Pout Fish story. (Like, I have it committed to memory.) No one likes this book. The illustrations are okay, but it is literally just a letter and a sea creature, sometimes with multiple letters per page. My older son did enjoy that the glitter rubs off, allowing you to have sparkling fingers (and, consequently, sparkling everything else you touch).

My son LOVES Pout Pout more than any other books and was so excited for this book to come out. It's super cute and has great colors. We were a little disappointed with how few touch option there are in this book though.

The touch and feel is a little misleading. I was expecting more spots to touch, but there was only one per two pages. Most of it is just slightly raised areas, but there are two glitter spots and one sticky spot (that has already lost the stickiness after a couple days). So, if you're really looking for a touch and feel experience, I wouldn't recommend this book. However, the book has cute illustrations and my daughter likes flipping through it. She does feel the spots, so it's doing its job. I would recommend it as a book, but like I said, if you're really looking for a good touch and feel experience, this isn't for you.

We love the Pout-Pout fish and thought this would be a great addition to our library. The touch and feel is lacking. There is one texture per two page spread and they aren't terribly exciting or unique. The shark and octopus have the most exciting textures but the others are redundant and even a little hard to find.

This is okay. All of the other pout pout fish books are awesome and exciting. This is exactly what the name implies, an alphabet book. IMO there isn't anything catchy or funny to the verbiage in the book, which was what I was expecting from Diesen.

I buy Pout Pout Fish books for my grandson. He loves the story books. The pictures are great in this book but the "touch and feel" aspect of this particular book was a little lacking but he still loves it.

It's not bad! My 5 yr old is really into sea creatures and it's perfect for him. He doesn't care as much about the touch and feel aspect but loves the pictures and can read it himself so he takes it to bed every night. For him it's perfect.
