

The Secret Language of Relationships adopts the format of its bestselling predecessor, The Secret Language of Birthdays, and the compendious collection of combinations that follows proves the book's assertion that "A relationship is a rather mysterious and amazing third entity, one that can come to lead an existence independent of the will or desire of its two partners.... in certain cases a relationship can prove far stronger than either individual, leading us to believe that a certain kind of synergy is at work." Well-organized, packed with fascinating "personality" information, and replete with snapshots (on every page) of famous couples--whether colleagues, spouses, or lovers--The

Gary Goldschneider began his study of human personality with an interest in biographies and psychoanalytic theory. Before deciding against a career in medicine, for three years he attended Yale Medical School, where he studied psychiatry. During this time he discovered his deep and abiding interest in astrology and its symbolic relationship to personality. Joost Elffers was born in Amsterdam. He created and produced numerous books over the past twenty years, including Play With Your Food and The 48 Laws of Power. He lives in New York.

I didn't find it to be accurate at all for all the relationships I read about through the book. I was disappointed because the birthday, although not totally accurate, is better.

This book belongs in every single person who loves astrologys collection. It's amazing how accurate it is. There are 2 other books in this series from Gary Goldschneider that are also "must haves"

There are a lot of other reviews of this book that all say about the same thing so I also recommend you also read them and see how similar the opinions are about the accuracy and usefulness of this book. I have read and researched many many books on relationships within astrology. This book is the most accurate and comprehensive that I have seen to date because the book breaks down each sign into 5 "subtypes." That is, there are 3 types within each sign and 2 covering cusp personality types on either end of the sign (i.e. Pisces-Aries Cusp, Aries I, II, II and Aries-Taurus Cusp). The beginning of the book provides a strikingly-accurate 2-page description of each subtype and then

goes on to cover each and every possible relationship combination of any two of the given subtypes. The authors dedicate a half-page for every conceivable combination. Every combo has a unique "name" that is the astrologer's take on the type of relationship (i.e. one relationship between two Leo subtypes, with the real-world example of Sean Penn & Madonna, is called "The Greatest Love of All"). It's pretty amusing and amazing what names the authors come up with for hundreds of pages of various combos. The descriptions are mostly devoted to romantic relationships, but there are also some short descriptions of work relationships and family relationships (parent-child or even sibling) within most of the combinations. Finally, for each subtype it gives "best" combination for love, marriage, work, parent-child, etc. It's important to note that what combination works best in "love" often does not always work in marriage! The inside cover of the book provides a handy cross section with pages to enable the reader to quickly locate a combo for any relationship. It may not be 100% accurate, but it's as close as I have seen in any book. If you want better you will have to have someone do a birth chart for each of you. Short of being an astrologer yourself or having a professional doing your charts, this book is REFERENCE CLASS for looking at relationship astrology. This book has proven to be so intriguing that you will find it being passed around to friends, people at work, at a party...and they'll all love it. It's one-of-a-kind and the author is truly gifted to have accurately captured the astrological implications of these relationships. I can't recommend this book highly enough.

This book is HUGE and a lot of work was put into it, but it doesn't seem very accurate. I have read plenty of astrology books and usually think afterward, "Nailed it!". Sadly, the girth of "The Secret Language of Relationships" gives extremely short, broad, and open ended relationship explanations. I read several relationship combinations and was dissatisfied when they didn't ring true.
