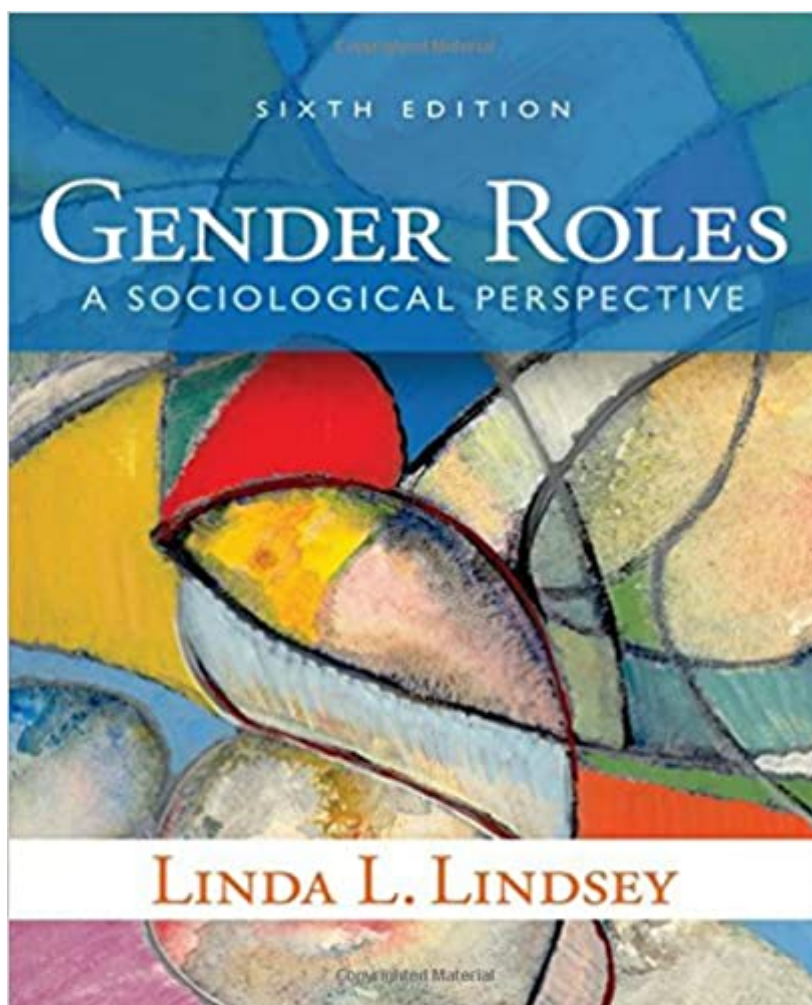

Linda Lee Lindsey is Professor Emeritus of Sociology at Maryville University of St. Louis, and Senior Lecturer in American Culture Studies at Washington University in St. Louis. She received her B.A. from University of Missouri of St. Louis and holds an M.A. and Ph.D. in sociology from Case Western Reserve University and a later M.A. in education from St. Louis University. Her research, writing, and teaching focus on gender, American diversity, globalization, and health and society. Her text, *Gender Roles: A Sociological Perspective* (6th edition) incorporates much of this research. She works extensively with the Asian Studies Development Program, a joint program of the East-West Center and University of Hawaii, assisting with institutes and leading professional development field seminars for college faculty in Asia. Fulbright and other grants and opportunities have allowed study in China, India, Pakistan, Japan, and Jordan. Work with NGOs on development efforts has also taken her to North and Sub-Saharan Africa. Global and diversity perspectives continue to inform her career, especially in writing for students and in offering gender perspectives to non-academic audiences. A longtime volunteer, she works with agencies on

behalf of women's advocacy, health, and relief and development. She is immediate Past President of the Midwest Sociological Society and has been elected to Who's Who in American Women and Who's Who in America.

This book has potential to be useful, but it is so poorly written that it's hard to pull out the important information. Every single page has at least two blatant run-on sentences (reading this book out loud is a challenge), and a comma is used instead of a period numerous times. Many sentences do not flow whatsoever, such as the following on page 110: "Women may self-disclose more frequently overall, but, they choose to learn more about their recently added Facebook friends, Self-disclosure may be mediated less by security issues for men compared to women." This book reminds me of a poorly written essay where the author is not only writing this the night before it's due, but is also trying to make it pages longer by filling it with useless adjectives and reiteration.
