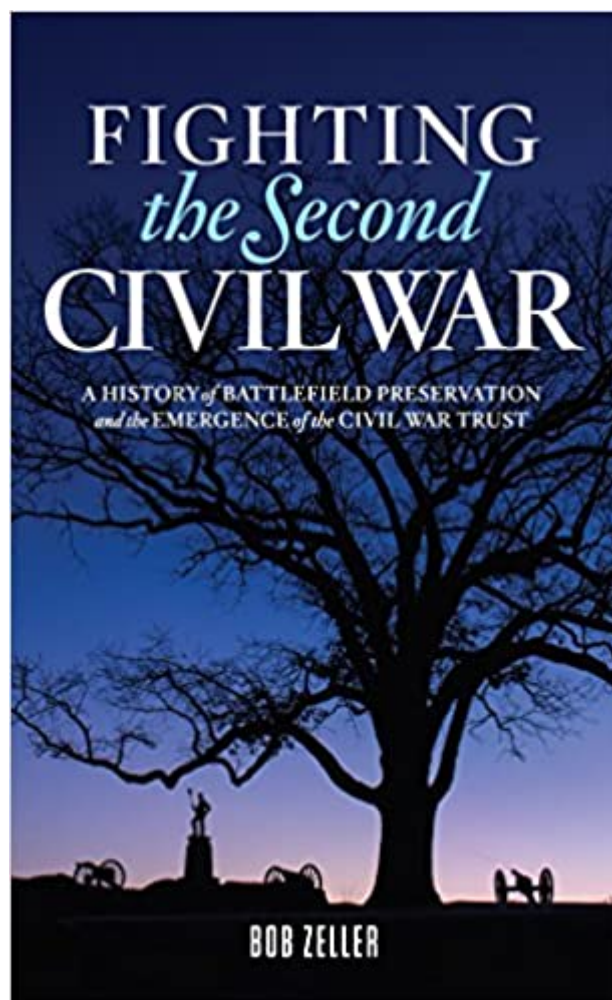

This work is like a stroll down memory lane for those of us old enough to be involved in supporting battlefield preservation over the last thirty years. Mr. Zeller has organized the book both topically
