

Chapters are broken into five major sections: Techniques, Heart of Algebra. Passport to Advanced Math, Problem Solving and Data Analysis, and Additional Topics in Math. Each chapter concludes with a reference list of similar questions from official practice tests. Practice questions are designated as either "Calculator" or "No calculator." Students will be forbidden from using their calculators for one whole section of the new SAT. Emphasis is placed on nimbleness--the ability to approach problems in multiple ways to find the one that works best. Calculator solutions and shortcuts are provided where appropriate. I am an SAT tutor and I literally have a closet full of different SAT prep books. This is by far, hands-down, the absolute best resource I've found for the math section of the new (2016) SAT. The author (Mike) has delivered an AMAZING resource that incorporates a unique and valuable combination of (a) top caliber understanding of math, (b) IN-DEPTH understanding of the test, (c) excellent organization, (d) crisp, clear writing and explanations, and (e) an infusion of humor that makes the book a joy to read. Not only does Mike give succinct and clear explanations on how to "do the math" for every topic, but he also shows short-cuts and techniques such as back-solving and plugging in. Furthermore, unlike most SAT math prep books, PWN the SAT Math Guide also

provides detailed instructions on how and when to use a graphing calculator. The book is organized by the topics covered by the new SAT; each chapter contains practice questions that look a lot like the actual questions that show up on the new SAT. After that, Mike lists actual new SAT test questions (from the College Board official practice tests) that are based on the topics covered by the chapter. He also has an "Official Test Breakdown" set of charts at the end of the book, in which he lists, in order, every single math question for the first 6 official SAT practice tests (and the 1 official PSAT practice test) and indicates which concept was being tested and which page of his book covers that concept. What an amazing, well-thought out, wonderful tool -- perfect for both the independent studier and those working with a tutor! (Seriously, if I could dream up a perfect SAT math prep book -- and I have daydreamed about such a resource for a long time -- this would be it!!)

This book is really useful but, the website that is provided isn't very useful in my opinion since it just provides stuff that is already free. The author has many problems and also explains many useful methods on how to do certain problems. When providing explanations to problems the author tries to add humor which makes it easier to understand how to do certain problems.

Excellent math prep book for the brand new 2016 SAT. Each section includes detailed reading of the actual content you need to know but also test strategies and tips. Tons of practice are available at the end of each mini section and more at the end of the chapter. Overall this is a must-have resource to get a leg up on the new test.
