

The signature on the front cover is Elmer Kelton's. As an author, he has always been generous about autographing books for his thousands of fans. This time we asked him to put his signature right up front. In many ways, these speeches, essays, or stories are his signature statement about many of the things he believes about the West, about writing, about history. Kelton fans, old and new, will cherish this keepsake edition.

The Texas Book Festival, the West Texas Book and Author Festival, and numerous other groups have honored ELMER KELTON with their lifetime achievement awards. He has written more than forty novels, including *The Time It Never Rained* and *The Good Old Boys*, and has won seven Spur Awards. The Western Writers of America in 1995 named him the greatest Western author of all time. Kelton also wrote *Christmas at the Ranch* (McWhiney Foundation Press, 2003).

It's a good book and E. Kelton knows how to lead us thru the western heritage. I encountered the same Cowboy spirit, that I was able to transfer into, although different genre, into the book "COR: Heart". Five stars. Love Elmer and his narrative.

Kelton's books reveal much of the Texas that was, especially west Texas in the 1920s thru 1950s, he was an excellent writer and knew how to write. He also had a great background in the lore and tales of that area of Texas at the bottom of the pandhandle, between El Paso and Ft. Worth. Highly recommend this book.
