

This book starts you out ONE note at a time-for those of us with no musical training it's perfect. It explains the recorder, notes and time signature in very easy to understand terms. The only thing missing is a chart of all the notes with finger positions in one place, but you can draw one up yourself in minutes. Worth the cost.

This book was purchased to replace one which was inadvertently given away. I had the original book for many years and played duets with a friend who also had a copy. It is really a great book!

The book give decent instruction but mixing C and F instruments on facing pages is very confusing to me and I play the recorder. The person I bought it for is even more confused. And the fingering charts are upside down (from all the books and fingering charts I've used.)

This is perfect for our needs. Two or more people can learn together, regardless of which recorder they have. It's fun and just hard enough to keep adults engaged.
