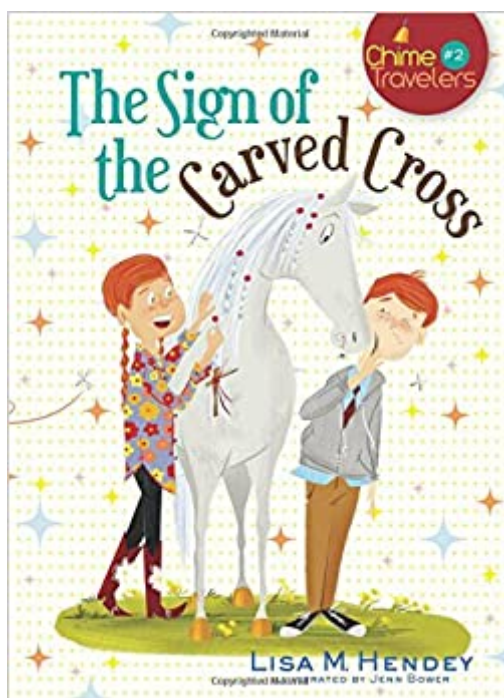



The Sign of the Carved Cross is a delightful introduction to St. Kateri Tekakwitha. While I remember hearing about St. Kateri in school and I remember her being canonized in 2012, I really didn’t know too much about her before reading this book. Not only is this a lovely, intimate way to learn about St. Kateri, but it’s a fun read as well. Hendey keeps the story moving along quickly, and young people will enjoy getting to know Katie and her family through this series. I love that the very “real life” problems of bullying and exclusion are worked so nicely into this story and in ways that children can easily relate to. The book also includes discussion questions, a prayer in honor of St. Kateri Tekakwitha, and a prayer before receiving Communion.

I teach a homeschool co-op book adventure class for 7 and 8 year olds. The kids and I all enjoyed this book. We learned about St Kateri and it put her story into a modern perspective.

Excellent choice for read aloud for any religious Ed teacher-- the saints and their stories of courage and faith can teach us so much! The books in this series would also make great gifts!
