These cards really resonate with me. There is a lot of mystery and connections revealed in these cards. The stock is normal but if taken care of can last a long time. The imagery is wonderful, very Disney's haunted mansion meets the earth realm. The court cards are left to be desired but the booklet that come with it, help to perpetuate a mindset that will help to connect to the cards. I love them!

In my over 45 year old career with Tarot, there has been no deck that did not have one of more cards that I just don't like. Well, that record has finally been broken by the Ghost Tarot. Amen and Hallelujah! Closely following the Waite Rider Tarot's structure, the awesome images of Ghost Tarot add profound nuances that speak very clearly to my intuitive heart & mind. As has been said in many reviews here, there's no aura of creepy firght-night horror to these cards. In fact, the poigniently romantic theme makes the cards' images very precious and valuable. [ETA] Some folks may

question the few pages in the multi language LWB. But nearly to a one, wach of the short statements are creatively unique and thought-provoking. Ghost Tarot is quickly making itself my favorite deck.

Okay use this for sad romance/relationship spreads. Itâ ÂTMs great for that. For me the computer generated images can be creative and amazing, as some are remarkable here! and then run of the mill, boring, trite majorities (those thrones, Jesus) â Â" those ones ruined this decks greater potential. The excuse that itâ ÂTMs what the under 25's expect/only care about is condescending/demeaning to their great minds, and an excuse for poor art. Can you tell I wanted to really love this deck? It robbed us of what could be even more powerful love readings - lazy art cheapens the medium's potential for me -- especially when there are more than a few really good images to show what it could have been. But isn't that why we collect? searching for the supreme tarot Grail. And so it continues.

Yes, as another has said, Rider-Waite overtones. A hauntingly beautiful deck, dark but not in a macabre way. The emotions clearly evoked in the expressions speak loud and clear and even in those cards where you can not see an expression, the intention displayed through the artistry speaks volumes. As to the imagery of this deck, Mssr. Corsi has done a superbly fantastic job in the artistic creation of each scene. The LWB which accompanies it comes with spartan information in comparison to many others (to be true) but in viewing each card with the description, one can use their imagination/instinct/intuition easily. Further insight may be obtained if needed by various internet sites devoted to tarot teachings. My first "dark" set of tarot cards and I am absolutely enthralled. One can not go wrong in the purchase of this deck in my opinion.

This is a great deck for shadow work and for those cold, winter nights too. I like the fact that it tackles the subjects of ghosts in a way that is subtle, sentimental, and beautiful.

Wow this deck is brutally honest. Deep. Great for shadow work. I bought it for samhein but changed my mind. For me anyway its good for shadow work. Card stock is ok. LWB is interesting different.

If your into spirits this is the deck for you! the cards you can easily read with the number ontop and which type of card it is on the bottom (wand, pentacles, cups and swords) So theres no confussion the horse head ontop is the knight card and the knights head ontop of the card is page. I have

grown up with spirits around me and saw them and these cards really bring out that spiritual side of me that gave me the gift in being able to see them. Wonderful deck!!!

I love these cards...they are traditionally sized and have a nice feel to them. The illustrations are beautiful, with a ghostly image on each card.
